As a Strong Start Parent and Child Time Facilitator, you will plan, deliver and evaluate developmentally appropriate activities and experiences to create a high-quality early learning and family-centered program for children aged 0-6 and their parents or caregivers.

Preferred qualifications and skills:

- Early Childhood Education (ECE) certificate, willingness to study for ECE certification, or relevant education in the Human Services field.
- Strong knowledge and awareness of age-appropriate programming and developmental needs of young children
- Ability to work professionally, collaboratively and respectfully with children and their families as well as with school, community and agency personnel.
- Desire to provide family-centred services with a focus on emotional and resource supports for parents.
- Good oral and written communication skills.
- Current first aid and Food Safe certificate (training provided if needed)
- Beneficial to have a Driver's licence and access to a reliable vehicle for work purposes.
- Criminal Record Check will be required.

Work Environment

- Program delivery may include in-person groups, online delivery via Zoom, creating take-home craft kits, meal deliveries to families' homes.
- Dependent on Public Health Orders at the time of employment, applicants must be willing to wear a mask if required for working in-person; and also be able to deliver programming via Zoom if needed.

Wage: \$23/hour

Schedule: up to 12 hours/week, with the potential of increased hours as mutually agreed upon. Preference will be given to candidates who can travel to Meadow Creek.
